**The Colliton Club is a registered private company limited by guarantee. It is a private members club, and has been in existence for more than 60 years. Applications for membership are always welcome.**

Formed in 1950, the Club was established by staff working with the county council to provide canteen and social facilities. It is self-financing, and leases the property from the County Council.

The Colliton Club has over 1600 members. It has been awarded 5 stars for health and hygiene by West Dorset Council, and provides breakfast, lunches and evening meals, using locally sourced food wherever possible.

There are also 2 bars providing a selection of coffees, tea, non-alcoholic and alcoholic drinks.

The Colliton Club occupies part of Colliton House, a mainly 17th Century Grade II listed building, containing some fine 16<sup>th</sup> century panelling and an 18<sup>th</sup> century staircase. It was formally the town house of the Churchill family and above the external porch is a cartouche containing the Churchill family arms.

The site is believed to be the location of the medieval hospital of St John The Baptist, fragments of which are in the County Museum.

Colliton House also featured in Thomas Hardy's Mayor of Casterbridge, as High-Place Hall, the home of Lucetta Templeman.

It also saw service as a VAD hospital in the Great War, with patients accommodated in marquees set up in Colliton Park.

## **COLLITON CLUB MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION**

### **Membership Categories:**

#### **1. Regular Membership - Annual Subscription £12.**

This generally applies to people who work in or have retired on pension from public sector bodies such as local government, health trusts or central government, or members of staff or bodies currently in the private sector that were formerly in the public sector. (DCC, WDDC, WPBC, Prison Officer, Firemen, Postmen, British gas workers etc.) Partners may also apply for Regular membership.

#### **2. Associate Membership – Annual subscription £12.**

This is for anyone not eligible under Regular Membership. Members of Club teams are also eligible under this category.

#### **Payment by deduction from salary:**

Dorset County Council, West Dorset District Council, Weymouth and Portland Borough Council and Dorset Fire and Rescue can collect membership by deduction from salary.

The deduction is in monthly instalments of the annual fee and renewal is automatic.

**RetiredSpecial:** (for those who wish to purchase a life membership). A one off fee of £55 for a single person or £65 for couples.

This applies only for Regular members who are in receipt of their State Pension.
